Spare poles can be purchased to replace broken poles ** Porch awnings will not be swapped because of broken poles**

> Please read the following instructions <u>carefully</u> <u>TIP:</u> Refer to the photograph to help when pitching your Annexe.

- Please do not leave for your vacation without fully erecting and checking the contents of your annexe.
- Ideally erect your annexe for some period allowing it to weather.
- Please make sure that before erecting, that you site the annexe <u>on clear Level ground</u> with no sharp objects underneath. (We recommend laying a groundsheet down to keep the annexe dry and clean)
- If you have any issues relating to pitching your annexe please contact your dealer for instructions before going on holiday.
- Please note this annexe is designed as a 'touring' annexe and not for 'permanent pitch' use

IMPORTANT PLEASE CHECK YOUR EQUIPMENT

(Make yourself familiar with the annexe and its parts before attempting to erect)

<u>Flysheet (or outer)</u> 2 x steel vertical poles 1 x curved top pole Pegs in separate bag

ERECTION INSTRUCTIONS.

Outdoor revolution Awnings are all erected outer first

- 1. Lay the outer/flysheet spread out on the ground. Slacken adjusters off on the black tapes (near the ring and pin assemblies) around the foot of the awning.
- Open the pole bag and lay the poles out on the ground. Take the shaped steel pole and attach the 2 legs to it. SPARE POLES CAN BE PURCHASED FROM <u>WWW.OUTDOOR-REVOLUTION.COM</u>, spares section.
- 3. Now decide which side of the awning you want the annexe and zip out the relevant panel. Take the annexe fly sheet and zip in.
- 4. Next take the annexe frame, when assembled this should form a 'goal post shape' however, before this the curved top pole should be pushed through the sleeve on the outside of the annexe at the end of the roof and the 2 legs attached. After this attach the ring of the 'ring and pin' assembly at the bottom of the canvas to tension the pole.
- 5. Now guy out the back of the flysheet. After this you are now ready to peg the annexe out
- 6. You are now ready to place the inner tent into position (suspending rear of inner first followed by the front) from the eyelets on the inside of the flysheet outer
- 7. Guy lines can now be tensioned and pegged on the annexe, please ensure in heavy weather that *ALL* guy lines are used. (Please note that failure to use all the lines may result in your Annexe being damaged)

Please note these few points for trouble free camping.

- a. After use please you always dry and air the tent before packing away.
- b. Any dirt or stains can be removed by brushing or gently washing with warm water. DO NOT use detergents as this will destroy the waterproofing on the fabrics.
- c. We advise that you DO NOT cook or smoke in this annexe; although the outer fabric is fire retardant treated it will still melt.
- d. Please make sure that you have a good time.

We highly recommend that you insure your annexe against storm damage or accidental damage, as the warranty does not cover such eventualities. The manufacturer <u>is not</u> liable for any damage caused to the caravan or vehicle because of misuse, incorrect pitching or extreme weather
